**Prerequisites** A grade of at least C- in your current math course.  
A recommendation from your current math teacher.  
The motivation and work habits to complete successfully in six weeks the course work of one year.

**Courses Offered** Geometry and Algebra 2

**Requirements** A grade of at least B- in your summer course to earn one Carnegie unit.  
If you do not, the summer course will not appear on your transcript.

No more than two absences – you risk dismissal from the program if you are absent for any reason more than two days.

A ruler, compass and protractor are required tools for Geometry.  
A graphing calculator is required for Algebra 2.

Register for the SY 2008 – 2009 math course for which your summer course prepares you.

The program cannot be used to avoid taking math during the school year.

**Registration** **Register by June 13.** Ask your math teacher to recommend you. A teacher recommendation form must be completed as part of your registration.
